
TO : All NCO's This Group.

3. A large building located about one-half mile from the Base can be moved to the Base, but the cost of moving must be paid.
4. A committee of NCO's inspected the building and reported it very suitable for a Club. The size is approximately 75 feet by 100 feet, with a good dance floor and a long bar.
5. Arrangements will be made to serve beer and meals to members and their families and guests at the NCO Club.
6. In order to meet initial expenses, move the building, establish the Club, etc., it is necessary for all men who are interested to sign below, indicating their willingness to contribute two dollars (\$2.00) as an initiation fee. This will be collected September payday. This is not a monthly dues but merely an initiation fee.
