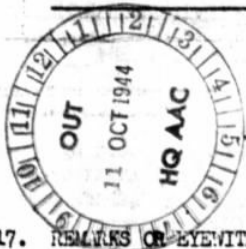

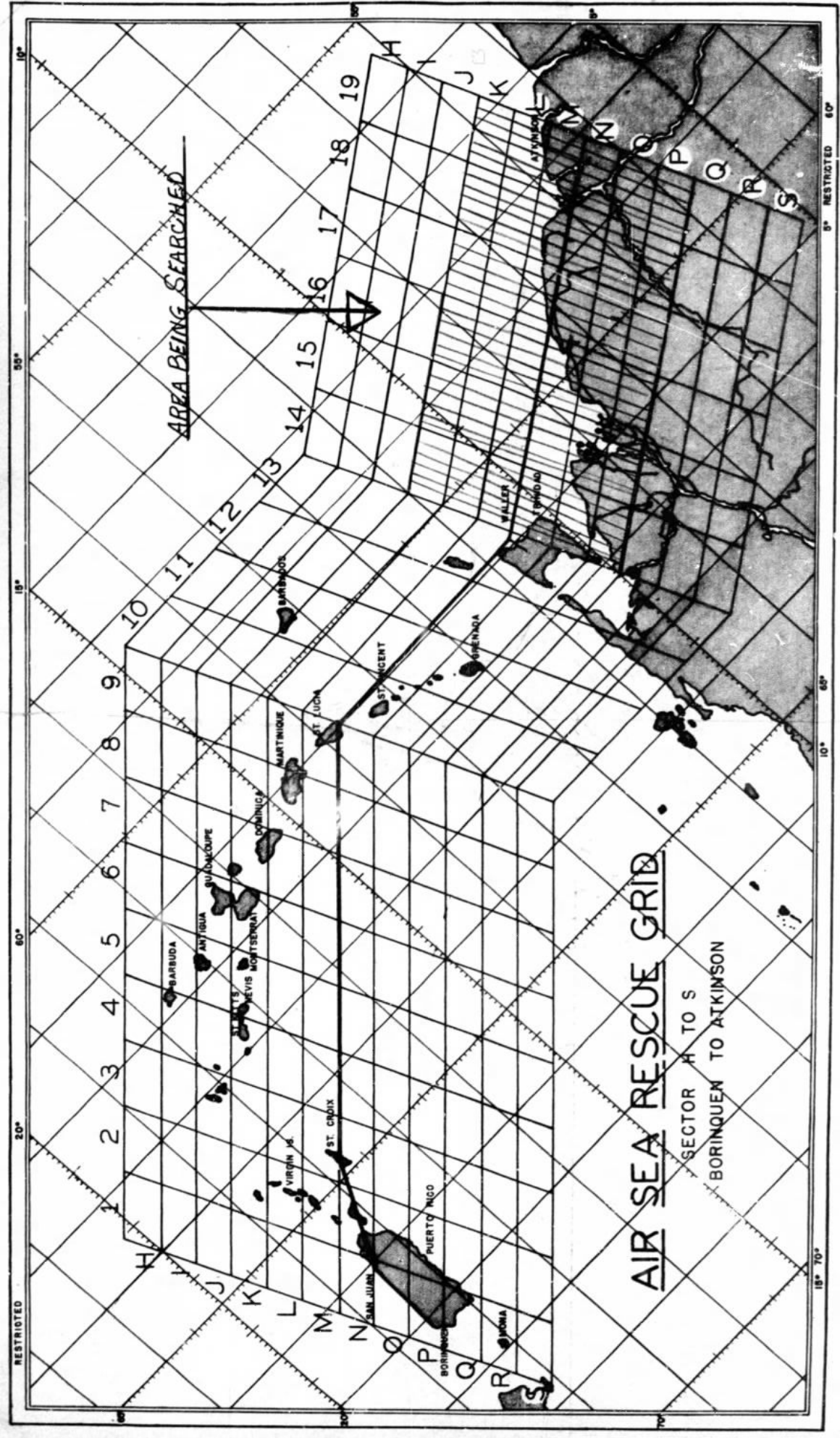

On 9 October 1944 aircraft type A-26B, serial number 43-22333 was reported missing enroute to Atkinson Field, B. G. from Borinquen Field, P. R. Radio contact was last made at 1347Z when the plane checked in as being over Walla field, Trinidad. Search by Army and Naval Aircraft was negative
