This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspid (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found.

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Kehoe:

I have received your letter pertaining to the remains of your son, the late First Lieutenant John W. Kehoe.

I can readily understand your need to be given the facts upon which the individual identification of your son's remains was established, and I deeply regret that you were not informed of their recovery and identification. I will gladly give you a summary of the steps by which his identification was accomplished.

In August of 1945, the British recovered the remains of a deceased military person near the wreckage of an American plane, in the vicinity of Muenstereifel, Germany. The American Graves Registration Service Unit active in that area reburied the remains in Plot KKK, Row 6, Grave 143, as "Unknown X-1270", and an investigation to determine the identity of the deceased was initiated.

An eyewitness of the crash reported that it occurred on 25 December 1944. The motor serial number and machine gun serial numbers taken from the wreckage identified the plane as the one of which your son was known to be the pilot on 25 December 1944. The Missing Air Crew Report for your son's plane shows that the plane had a two-man crew on that day, and the identified remains of the person known to be the other occupant were also recovered by the British in the same location, near Muenstereifel.

The clothing on the deceased bore the marks "KEH" and "X-2829", your son's laundry marks, the initial "K" corresponding with the first initial of his last name, and the "2829" with the last four digits of his enlisted serial number which was 32 192 829. Physical characteristics of the deceased agree favorably with those of your son. Finally, a tooth chart made from the remains compares very favorably with the dental chart maintained in Army records for your son. I might add that identification experts consider favorable comparison of dental charts a very good means of identification.

It is on the data given on page one that the Department of the Army bases its determination that the remains now resting in Plot KKK, Row 6, Grave 143, in the United States Military Cemetery, Margraten, are those of your son. I am gratified to inform you of the manner in which this identification was accomplished, but again I wish to express my regret that you were not informed of this prior to the mailing of the "Request for Disposition of Remains" form to the next of kin.

I note that the Disposition Form, dated 5 December 1947, was forwarded to Mrs. Christine Kehoe, who is shown on our records as the legal next of kin of your son. Unless she has remarried since his death, she retains the right to direct the final disposition of his remains. If she has remarried, she may indicate her remarriage by completing Part III of the Disposition Form, or if she wishes to relinquish her prior disposition right, she may do so by completing and signing Part II of the form. In either case, the Department of the Army may then accept the form with pages one and two completed and signed by the father.

I hope this letter will lessen your anxiety regarding the proper identification of your son's remains. Please accept my sympathy in your great loss.

BASIS FOR IDENTIFICATION

1. Unknown X-1270 was found by wreckage of a twin engine bomber near Munstereifiel, Germany, bearing motor serial number GB 577848 and following machine gun serial numbers; 641270, 641197, 641241, and 997713. KEH and K-2829 were laundry marks found on deceased's clothing, also flying clothing and officer's type shirt.
2. Information received from Air Forces reveals that a twin engine bomber (A-26B-20) crashed 25 December 1944 near Blankenheim, Germany, with following machine gun serial numbers in agreement; 641270, 641197, and 641241. The pilot of the bomber was: KEHOE, John W., 1st Lt, 0-758184. (MACR #11923 Exhibit #1)
3. Official German Records (Exhibit #2) state bomber crashed 25 December 1944, and the pilot 1st Lt John W. KEHOE, 0-758184 and another man were killed. Air Forces, ACO Report of Death and Official German Records are in agreement with Unknown X-1270 in regard to date of death.
4. Unknown's clothing with laundry marks KEH and K-2829 check with Lt. KEHOE'S record as an enlisted man - John W. KEHOE, 32192829. Estimated height of deceased is 5'9", Lt. KEHOE'S height was 5'10". AGO Finding of Death, Air Force Records and Official German Records agree with Unknown's place of death. (Munstereifiel, Germany 50.33N, 6.47E; Blankenheim, Germany 50.26N, 6.39E; Euskirchen 50.40N, 6.46E - Approx. 8 mi N. of Munstereifiel, Blankenheim is approx. 10 mi SW of Munstereifiel).
5. MACR indicates plane had a two man crew - Lt. KEHOE and Cpl Robert F. Graham, 19091471, who has been identified by ID tags. The remains of Unknown X-1270 were picked up (by English) at same location as Cpl Graham - Munstereifiel.
6. Tooth chart for Unknown X-1270 compares very favorably with dental chart for 1st Lt. John W. KEHOE, 0-758184. (Exhibit #3) Shoe size for Lt. KEHOE is not available for comparison.
