On the 5th day I met a Priest who put me in touch with the organisation and took me to DOULLENS (Sheet 5, N 18) where I stayed for about two weeks.

I was then taken to AMIENS (N 15) where I stayed until the town was liberated on 31 Aug 44. I left AMIENS on 1 Sep 44 and got a lift down to EVREUX (?) (Sheet 7, R 16).
