PIMA AIR & SPACE MUSEUM



Included with the basic registration fee is a tour of the **Pima Air & Space Museum**, located in Tucson, Arizona. One of the world's largest non-government funded aerospace museums. The museum features a display of nearly 300 aircraft spread out over 80 acres. The museum has four display hangars in addition to a restoration hangar.

Key aircraft on exhibit include the SR-71 Blackbird, A-10 Warthog, B-29 Superfortress, B-24 Liberator, B-17 Flying Fortress, B-36 Peacemaker, and an A-20 Havoc.

- A private group walking tour will be conducted which lasts about 1 hour. After this private tour, guests are free to explore on their own.
- A narrated Tram Tour is available that takes passengers through the museum's outdoor displays on a 1.5-mile circuit. The tram tour cost \$8 per person.
- Dining facilities are available on site.



On Thursday, October 27th, we will car-pool from the hotel to the museum, located about 10 miles from the hotel.

MT. LEMMON SKYCENTER



The Mount Lemmon SkyCenter is part of Steward Observatory and the University of Arizona's College of Science. It serves to connect the public with cutting-edge space science research and discoveries. The world-class resources atop Mount Lemmon, provide exciting opportunities to explore our Universe.

This is an optional activity, and the cost is \$85 per person.

On Friday, October 28th, we will car-pool from the hotel to Mt. Lemmon. This five-hour program starts two hours prior to sunset and includes an astronomy lecture, a light dinner, sunset, and guided navigation of the night sky. The program starts with binoculars and ends with views through the Schulman 32-inch and/or the Phillips 24-inch telescopes. Views may include our spectacular neighboring planets, distant galaxies and nebula, star clusters, and other celestial wonders. The lunar cycle on Oct 28th is a waxing crescent with about 10% illumination. The sky will be dark which is advantageous for astronomical observations.

Please Note: The SkyCenter is at an elevation of 9,157 feet and it will be very cold up there.

Be prepared with clothing layers, a heavy coat, fully enclosed shoes, gloves, a hat, and other items you may wish to have to keep warm during the visit.
