At 11,000 feet a total of 75 bombs were dropped in the target area with fair results. Visibility was 4 to 5 miles over England and channel on route out and 10 miles at target with .3 to .4 altocumulus at 15,000 feet. No anti-aircraft fire was experienced. No enemy aircraft encountered. Planes landed at 2007.
