- 1. Sgt Robert L. Cochran, 34 764 279, AC, 670th Bomb Sq (L), 416th Bomb Gp (L), was killed in action, 19 July 1944, flying as mechanic gunner when he was struck by flak while on an operational mission near Bruz, France.
- 2. 2D LT (then Flight Officer) ROBERT C. BYRNE, JR, O 887 260, AC, pilot of A20G-43-9689, made an emergency landing at Strip A-14, in an effort to obtain immediate medical attention for the gunner. The soldier was pronounced dead upon arrival of medical personnel, and his remains buried at Monarch Cemetery, Plosville, France. 19 July 44
- 3. This organization was operating from Wethersfield, Essex, England at the time of the casualty, and all efforts to obtain the medical diagnosis were unsuccessful.
- 4. Pvt William D. Cummings, 33 671 548, was armorer gunner and remaining crew member.






