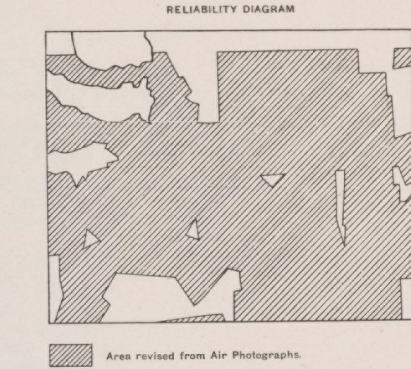


ROADS IN HOLLAND
Road Classification is not based on reconnaissance, its reliability is uncertain.

- National Highways (Rijkswegen) with 2 carriage ways, each over 6 metres wide, metalled 1 way M.T.
- National Highways (Rijkswegen) with 1 carriage way & 1/2 metre wide, metalled 1 way M.T.
- Other Main Roads, generally 5 metres wide or over, metalled. (Usually 2-way M.T.)
- Secondary Roads, generally about 4 metres wide, metalled. (Usually 1-way M.T.)
- Roads with Tramway
- Other Roads

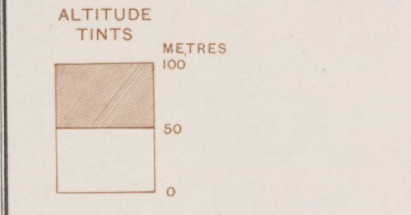
