SUBJECT: Request for Information of Deceased Personnel.

TO : Commanding General, IX Bombardment Division, APO 140, US Army.

1. Reports of Burial have been received at this headquarters for two deceased airmen believed to have been former members of your command, who were killed in a plane crash in the vicinity of Krewinkel, Belgium, approximately 20 January 1945. Since no identification could be found on either of the remains, they were designated as Unknown X-10 and Unknown X-11, U. S. Military Cemetery No. 1, Foy, Belgium.

2. Information received concerning the plane indicated that it was an A-26 model, serial number 43-22317. Four Browning Machine guns, 50 caliber, M2, found in the wreckage had the following serial numbers:

1276389
1276077

1276206
1276220

The XIX Tactical Air Command informed this headquarters that the crew of the plane consisted of 1st Lt Robert R. Svenson, O-752453, and S/Sgt Phillip C. Fild, 35533423.

3. The only clue to the identification of the remains was a pair of government issue shoes, size 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ -D, found on the remains of Unknown X-10. It is requested that information be furnished this headquarters concerning the size of shoe worn by Lt Svenson and S/Sgt Fild. It is also requested that former friends of the deceased be contacted in an effort to determine the type of shoe (civilian low-cut or government issue) worn by the deceased at the time of the accident.

4. Identification of the individual remains will have to be made on the basis of the one available clue, the shoe size. Every attempt should be made to obtain the information requested above.

c. Aircraft type A26B-15 43-22317 crewed by the above mentioned personnel was reported missing in action 25 December 1944 in the vicinity of Krewinkel, Belgium and not on the 20 January 1945 as referred originally in your letter.

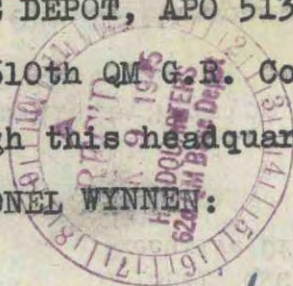

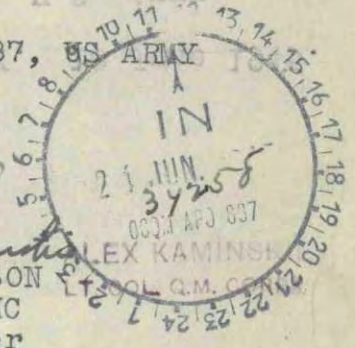

Dear Mrs. Fild:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

1. Reports of Burial have been received at this headquarters for two deceased airmen believed to have been former members of your command, who were killed in a plane crash in the vicinity of Krewinkel, Belgium, approximately 20 January 1945. Since no identification could be found on either of the remains, they were designated as Unknown X-10 and Unknown X-11, U. S. Military Cemetery No 1, Foy, Belgium.
2. Information received concerning the plane indicated that it was an A-26 model serial number 43-22317. Four Browning Machine guns, 50 caliber, M2, found in the wreckage had the following serial numbers :

The XIX Tactical Air Command informed this headquarters that the crew of the plane consisted of 1st Lt. Robert R. Svenson, O-752453, and S/ Sgt Philip G. Fild 35533423.

It is requested that information be furnished this headquarters concerning the size of shoe worn by Lt Svenson and S/Sgt Fild. It is also requested that former friends of the deceased be contacted in an effort to determine the type of shoe (civilian low-cut or government issue) worn by the deceased at the time of the accident.

4. Identification of the individual remains will have to be made on the basis of the one available clue, the shoe size. Every attempt should be made to obtain the information requested above.
