Dear Mr. Pepe:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

I have received for reply your letter of 18 December 1944, addressed to the Commanding General of the Army Air Forces, in which you request further information concerning your son, Corporal Samuel A. Pepe.

I fully realize your desire to know the circumstances attending your son's death and I regret that no information has been received in the War Department, other than the original casualty report which stated that your son was killed 10 November 1944, in an airplane crash in Fontainebleau, France. You may be assured, however, that any additional reports that may become available, regarding your son, will be conveyed to you promptly.

May I explain that in order to fulfill the vital responsibility of submitting reports in the most expeditious manner, our overseas Commanders in death cases forward an individual report for each casualty and do not indicate the names of those who comprised a certain crew. I understand how much it would mean to you to know the names of those who were in your son's plane and I am indeed sorry that this information is, at the present time, not available in the War Department.

With regard to your request for a photograph of your son's grave I wish to advise you that the Quartermaster General, Washington 25, D. C., has jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to the burial of our military personnel who die overseas and I am, therefore, forwarding a copy of your letter to that official for appropriate attention to your request.

I realize how futile any words of mine may be to assuage your grief, and I assure you that my heartfelt sympathy is with you in your bereavement.

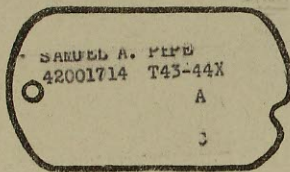
