Oprep A Number 41 for 24 hours ending sunset 11 May 1944. Mission Number 43. IX Bomber Command Field Order Number 308.

- A. Formation consisted of two bones. 18 ships box I and 20 ships box II. Take off time was 0900. Target Cormsilles En Vexin Airfield. Time over target 1036. Box I, at 12,000 feet, dropped a total of 72 bombs in the target area with fair results. Box II returned early from point over channel 4 miles off Letreport. Had no visual contact with box I in thick haze and did not see fighter excort. Visibility over France was 6 to 8 miles in haze. Anti-aircraft fire was moderate and accurate HFF in wooded area 3 miles north of Neufchatel, 8 ships receiving category A damage and 1 ship receiving category AC damage. No anti-aircraft fire was experienced over target area. No enemy aircraft encountered. Planes landed at 1159.
